A great opportunity for Year 11 students to practice interview skills. Students will prepare in the lessons before, then spend 15 minutes being interviewed by a business volunteer, who will provide feedback at the end.



PS16 Timeline

- \Rightarrow September to January 1 to 1 Careers Advise appointment with Lee Flanagan.
- ⇒ **29th September** Y11 Mock Interviews
- ⇒ **5th October** Post-16 Transition Parents' Evening
- ⇒ **October and November** Visit College Open Days and attend Lunchtime Talks.
- ⇒ **23rd October to 10th November** Personal Statement writing, PS16 Login Issued – Complete profile section and start to add courses to favourites.
- \Rightarrow Applications need to be completed by **Christmas** to give time for checking.
- ⇒ 10th January Predicted Grades will be uploaded for you course choices will then be checked against your predicted grades.
- ⇒ 12th January Final application deadline for students. Tutor references are completed.
- ⇒ School will review and send off all applications to college providers by 31st January.
- \Rightarrow February to April Post-16 College Interviews take place.
- ⇒ March to May Colleges make offers to students. Students accept or decline the offer.



What are T-Levels?

T-Levels are new 2 year qualifications that have been designed with employers to give young people a head start towards the careers they want. A T-Level is equivalent to 3 A levels and attracts the same UCAS points. They combine classroom work with an extended industry placement. Watch this video to find out more.
